Online Safety-Please remember that most online applications have a lower limit of 13 years old. This means that no child in this school should be using apps such as TikTok, Snapchat, Watts App, Instagram. The reason for the lower age limit is that it is deemed that children under 13 years are not emotionally mature enough to be able to use these type of apps, and as such often experience inappropriate content. Often conversations and group chats start with the most innocent intentions, but as it is easy to misunderstand comments when they are not face to face, even the most innocent group chat can change to something that causes upset. Clearly this is something that we know parents and carers, alongside school, will want to avoid and so school asks that parents support children at home and closely monitor all online devices to ensure that these apps are not used by children in this school. Week beginning 11th March is Anti-bullying week and we will be covering onlinebullying with pupils.


